If you read it cover to cover, you'll know more than 90% of bong shoppers — and you'll buy your next piece based on what actually fits **you**, not what looked best on someone else's shelf.

"There are two kinds of bong shoppers. The first kind walks in and buys the prettiest piece on the wall. The second kind reads a cheat sheet like this one. We'd really like you to be the second kind."

Answer five quick questions. Track your most-frequent letter (A, B, C, or D). Your buyer profile is on **page 8**, with a perc match and an honest price tier.

QUESTION 01 · EXPERIENCE

When you imagine yourself using a bong, you're...

- A Brand new — this is my first piece
- B A few pieces in, ready to upgrade
- C Experienced — I want a flagship
- D Casual — gift / occasional use

QUESTION 02 · LUNGS

Be honest — how's your lung capacity?

- A Limited — I cough easily
- B Average — I do fine with most pieces
- C Big lungs — bring on the drag
- D Honestly haven't thought about it

QUESTION 03 · MATERIAL

What are you mostly going to use it for?

- A Flower only
- B Both flower and concentrates
- C Concentrates / dabs primarily
- D Not sure yet

QUESTION 04 · CLEANING

How often will you actually clean it?

- A Honestly? Almost never
- B Every couple of weeks
- C Weekly — I'm a clean-glass person
- D Whenever I notice it's dirty

QUESTION 05 · BUDGET

What's your honest budget ceiling?

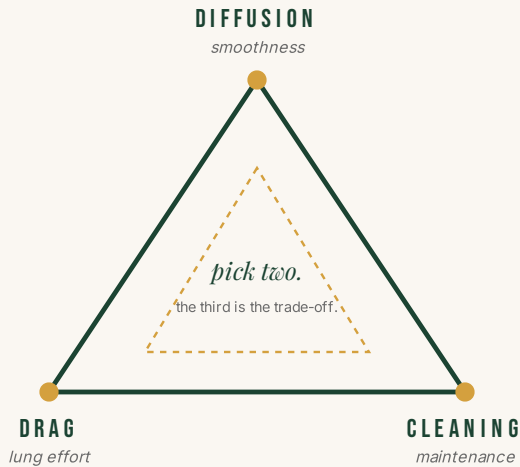

SCORING SIMPLE

Tally your A's, B's, C's, and D's. Your most-frequent letter is your buyer profile. Tied between two letters? Read both on page 8 and pick the one that feels closer.

The Iron Triangle *of Perc Design*

Every percolator on the market is a deliberate trade-off between three competing priorities. You can't max out all three. Once you accept this, perc shopping gets dramatically simpler — you just decide which two corners matter most to you.



More diffusion = smoother hits

Smaller, denser bubbles cool the smoke faster and filter more particulates. But higher diffusion *always* means higher drag and harder cleaning.

Less drag = easier to clear

Bigger holes and simpler geometry mean you don't have to pull as hard. The trade-off is less aggressive cooling.

Easier cleaning = lower maintenance

Open geometry without intricate welds. The trade-off is fewer bubbles and less drama.

THE RULE

A clean cheap bong outperforms a dirty expensive one. Match the perc to your **actual** lung capacity and cleaning rhythm — not your budget ceiling.

Why this matters: most people overspend on diffusion they can't actually use. A \$90 single honeycomb beats a \$300 stereo matrix for someone who can't comfortably clear a stereo matrix.

The Lung Capacity *Self-Test*

This is the single most overlooked factor in bong buying — and the #1 reason expensive pieces end up unused. Match the perc to **your** lungs, not the influencer who sold you on the piece.

TIER 1 · LIMITED

You cough easily, have asthma, or smaller lung volume

→ *Quick test: Can you blow up a balloon in one continuous breath without pausing?*

Your perc tier: Single honeycomb · Single ratchet · Single inline · Single showerhead. Stay under one perc until you've owned a piece for a few months and know your tolerance.

TIER 2 · AVERAGE

You're most adult buyers — capable, not superhuman

→ *Quick test: Can you hold your breath comfortably for 30 seconds?*

Your perc tier: Double honeycomb · Single tree · Showerhead + inline combo · Single matrix · Turbine. Two-stage filtration is your sweet spot.

TIER 3 · HIGH

Athletes, swimmers, experienced smokers, big lungs

→ *Quick test: Can you clear a 14-inch beaker bong in one steady pull?*

Your perc tier: Stereo matrix · Triple honeycomb · Fritted disc (flower only) · Multi-perc combos · Anything you want, frankly. The drag is fine for you.

PRO TIP

If you can borrow a friend's bong with your target perc style, **try clearing it before you buy**. One real test beats every spec sheet ever written.

! READ THIS BEFORE BUYING A FRITTED DISC

Fritted discs are the smoothest perc on the market — and the most fragile to concentrate residue. They clog within days if you dab. Flower only, or skip it.

Cleaning Reality Check + *Critical Don'ts*

A dirty perc actively ruins your bong — kills diffusion, multiplies drag, ruins flavor. Honest cleaning rhythms matter more than how expensive your piece is.

THE WEEKLY DEEP CLEAN

- Pour out the water immediately after every session — never let it sit
- Add 91%+ isopropyl alcohol + a generous tablespoon of coarse salt (Epsom or kosher)
- Plug both ends with bong stoppers (or your thumbs, in a pinch)
- Shake gently — let the salt do the abrasive work
- Soak 15–30 minutes for stubborn perc resin
- Rinse with warm water until no alcohol smell remains

FREQUENCY BY PERC TYPE

- **Fritted disc:** every 3–5 sessions
- **Honeycomb:** every 5–8 sessions
- **Tree / matrix / jellyfish:** every 5–7 sessions
- **Inline / showerhead / donut:** every 7–10 sessions
- **Glycerin coils:** every 2–3 sessions, then re-freeze

NEVER USE BOILING WATER



The biggest mistake new perc owners make. Borosilicate glass is durable, but the welds inside percolators are thermally fragile. Boiling water cracks them invisibly — your bong will look fine, then fail. Warm water only. Always.

FIVE WAYS TO KILL YOUR BONG

- × Boiling water on a perc — instant invisible cracks
- × Letting water sit in the chamber overnight
- × Aggressive scrubbing on tree perc arms — they snap
- × Skipping the rinse after iso/salt cleaning
- × Using a fritted disc with concentrates — clogs in days

FIVE WAYS TO EXTEND ITS LIFE

- Add a removable ash catcher — pre-filters debris
- Use bong plugs for splash-free shake cleaning
- Store on a stable, padded surface — never on a wobbly shelf
- Replace water at the start of each session
- Travel with the downstem and bowl removed and wrapped

Your Buyer *Profile*

Look up the letter you tallied most often on the quiz (page 3). Tied? Read both — you're a hybrid, and either profile will land you in the right zone.



The Cautious Beginner

You're new to bongs, throat-sensitive, budget-conscious, low-maintenance.

Your match: Single honeycomb or single showerhead bong, 10–14 inches, \$60–120. Skip multi-perc anything for now. Add a basic ash catcher to extend cleaning intervals.



The Balanced Upgrader

You've owned a piece or two, you know what you like, you want a real upgrade.

Your match: Double honeycomb, single tree perc, or showerhead + inline combo. \$120–220. This is the ROI sweet spot — you'll feel a meaningful jump in smoothness without overpaying for diffusion you can't use.



The Flagship Buyer

You're experienced, you have the lungs for it, you want a centerpiece.

Your match: Stereo matrix, triple honeycomb, multi-perc flagship, or a glycerin coil system. \$250–500+. Make sure you can clear it comfortably before you commit. The "wow" factor doesn't matter if it sits unused.



The Honest "Not Sure Yet"

You haven't bought yet, you don't know what you don't know, you want a safe pick.

Your match: Single honeycomb beaker bong, 12 inches, \$80–120, with a removable downstem. It's the perc most people end up keeping after they've owned a few bongs anyway — you're just skipping the trial-and-error phase.

REAL TALK

No matter your profile, your **cleaning rhythm** matters more than perc complexity. A clean Tier 1 perc always outperforms a dirty Tier 3 perc.

Highway 420's *Honest Picks*

Categories, not specific products — because our inventory shifts. Visit highway420.com to see current matches in each tier. These are the categories we'd point our own friends to.

BEST FIRST BONG

Category: Single honeycomb beaker · 10–14"

Price tier: \$60–120

Why we pick it: Forgiving, easy to clean, low drag, real diffusion improvement over a basic bong. The piece most people wish they'd bought first.

BEST UNDER \$100

Category: Single honeycomb or single showerhead

Price tier: \$80–100

Why we pick it: Highest ROI in our entire catalog. You don't get meaningfully better hits by spending 3× more — you just get more drag.

BEST PREMIUM MULTI-PERC

Category: Inline + tree, or double-honeycomb

Price tier: \$180–280

Why we pick it: Two-stage filtration that's smoother than any single-perc bong without going overboard on drag. The serious-smoker upgrade that's actually worth it.

BEST FOR CONCENTRATES

Category: Showerhead dab rig (avoid fritted)

Price tier: \$90–180

Why we pick it: Larger slits resist concentrate clog. Smaller chambers concentrate vapor for better flavor. Designed for your material, not retrofitted from a flower bong.

BEST FOR COUGHERS

Category: Glycerin coil bong

Price tier: \$120–250

Why we pick it: Frozen glycerin holds cold longer than ice. The hit feels closer to cold air than warm vapor. If you've been chasing the "smooth" feeling other bongs don't deliver, this is the answer.

BEST SHOWPIECE

Category: Stereo matrix · turbine · artisan

Price tier: \$250–500+

Why we pick it: When the bong is going on the shelf as a centerpiece. Just be honest with yourself about lung capacity before committing — these are flagship-level drag.
